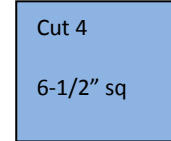
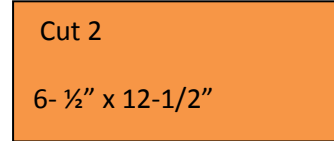


Supplies Needed:

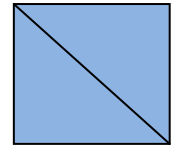
2 6 ½ x 12 ½ rectangles floral fabric (Background)

4 6 ½ x 6 ½ squares of tone on tone (Focus)

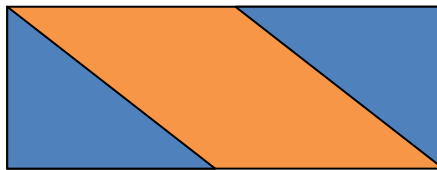
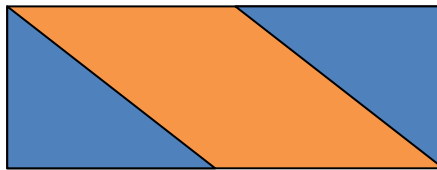


Directions:

- 1) On the wrong side of all four 6.5" squares, tone on tone, Focus fabric, draw a diagonal line through the center of the squares as shown.



- 2) Take one of the marked 6.5" squares of Focus fabric and one of the 6.5" x 12.5" Background rectangles and place them right sides together with the 6.5" square in the left corner of the rectangle. The diagonal line should run from the upper left to the lower right of the square. Then repeat this in the right corner of the rectangle, with the diagonal line running the same way as the first.
- 3) Repeat step 2 with the other 6.5" x 12.5" Background rectangle and the 2 remaining 6.5" squares.
- 4) Trim 1/4" away from the sewn diagonal line and press the seam allowance towards the corners. Your two rectangles should now look like this.



- 5) Now you are ready to sew the two 6.5" x 12.5" Rectangles together. Once you are complete, your block should measure 12.5" square at this point.
